

The Europa Hochschule EurAka CH (E.H.E. European University EurAka Switzerland)



The E.H.E. Europa Hochschule EurAka CH, internationally known as the private European University EurAka Switzerland, is an independent and private University for integral medicine, technology, and economics. The E.H.E. EurAka is situated in Therwil (Switzerland) and legalised by the Swiss Federal Republic and the Canton Basel-Landschaft as private University. The status of the private EurAka University is officially confirmed as 'non-contributory private institution' according to the Swiss Higher Education Act (HFKG). The E.H.E. EurAka is officially approved to award Swiss Bachelor, Master's, and doctoral degrees.

The E.H.E. EurAka was constituted in 1985. The University provides national and international research and programmes of studies in the fields of Integral Medicine, Technological Sciences, and Business Sciences. The E.H.E. EurAka research, especially in technology and engineering, owns highest international reputation and attracts significant research funding from global

corporations and European Governments.

Upon recommendation by the State-Council of the Swiss Republic and the Canton Ticino, the E.H.E. EurAka has received official Degree Awarding Powers in the year 2000. The status of Degree and Research Degree Awarding Powers was reapproved by the country's various regulatory authorities in 2006, such as the Dipartimento della cultura e dell' educazione dello Sport, Ticino, and by the Canton Basel-Landschaft in 2016. They concluded that the E.H.E. Europa Hochschule EurAka CH is fully aligned with the laws of Switzerland and thus officially approved as Swiss "Hochschule on the level of University".

Switzerland itself is aligned with the so-called Bologna Process of the European Union making Degrees of the University cognate across Europe and beyond. Hence, the University awards Degrees with ECTS credits.

Delivering studies in often very distant countries means trust first of all. The E.H.E. EurAka has established internationally acknowledged academic standards according to DIN EN ISO / IEC 17024. We must have the confidence that national centres of studies are exactly delivering this same quality.

This is not just a question of equality regarding graduates' skills and knowledge, it also is a prerequisite regarding applicable regulations in our country of origin and additionally, in the host country of the delivery of our studies.

To assure such equal quality, the E.H.E. EurAka collaborates with carefully selected partner institutes in Africa, Asia, and Europe. Students can trust that they are getting the same high quality as if studying with the E.H.E. EurAka herself.



International Business in the 21st Century

"We can't speak day after day about globalization without at the same time having in mind that ... we need multilateral solutions" (Dominique Strauss-Kahn)." Some favour globalisation, some oppose it. Whatever the opinion is, it exists and will not disappear. Therefore, multilateral solutions for global goods and services are needed.

These solutions are based on analysis, knowledge, skills, and experiences. Basic economic or international knowledge is insufficient. Just speaking a foreign language is nothing more than to understand what another party says, but very different to what it may really mean.

This is where the knowledgeable specialist is needed. This is where the advantages of the studies in international business add their advantages: understanding multicultural differences; knowing about different regulations, trade terms and practices; being able to analyse on international ground; and so much more.

The Bachelor in International Business of the E.H.E. EurAka was designed by specialists, who do not only have an academic reputation. They have many years of highlevel managerial experiences at the same time. I.e., they perfectly know, what is important and where the emphasis is.

Studying this bachelor programme offers graduates of the E.H.E. In addition, these studies offer a voluntary, but recommended opportunity to embark on an internship, best on international ground. The Bachelor in International Business



Key Elements of the Programme:

The Bachelor in International Business is preparing candidates for responsible and qualified roles in internationally-oriented organisations, e.g., import/export, or for self-employment, e.g., as consultant.

Contemporary modules qualify graduates to work in various functions. Through wide perspectives, they have highest levels of expertise and value-oriented skills. E.H.E. EurAka graduates excel through crossfunctional and interdisciplinary knowledge, which can be directly applied in the globalised world of organisations.

The BIB programme comprises three years as standard period of studies. It is conform with European requirements. As standard, the Degree awards 180 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System). The Bachelor in International Business strongly emphasises the concept of Employability Impact.

- Introduction to critical thinking and analytical approaches to theories and practices of globalised organisational contexts by analysing the internal and external environment.
- Furthering the ability to read, understand and make sense of the specific organisational needs for sustainable international progress in a variety of businesses and contexts.
- Development of the capacity to evaluate and critically analyse, how organisational functions effectively and efficiently interact in global contexts.
- To provide insights into economies, markets, and global drivers, which are influencing organisations and how these may develop strategies for sustainable international progress.
- Apply own high standards of moral and ethical behaviour.

Graduates are awarded with the

- **Certificate of the Bachelor in International Business** being officially approved and part of the Process of Harmonisation of Higher Education in Europe (Bologna Process)
- Transcript in form of the official Diploma Supplement 'Europeass' of the European Union facilitating continuation to Master's studies internationally

Key Objectives

The programme introduces students to theory, one being applicable in practice. Case study insights and practical demonstrations are part of the programme to develop useful professional and future leadership skills. They are important for the discovery of the own problem-solving capacity in international business.

The BIB programme covers profound understanding of present and future problems and challenges, which contemporary organisations are facing. But most essentially, it is about identifying those opportunities, which today's globalised economy offers.

All that starts with analysis: researching the drivers of organisational development to meet the needs of demanding multinational markets. Then it is also about the many multicultural organisational stakeholder contexts. International business is professional roles, which are effectively contributing to the management of the international organisation. This means wider corporate responsibilities in the global economy as well.

The international business manager explores organisational effectiveness and functional efficiencies for high-level performance and viability.



For increased Employability Impact students can opt for an internship with an organisation of their choice. This offers experiences in practice in which knowledge gained on the BIB programme is extended. Such internship further increases graduates' attractiveness, when they apply for a job.

The optional internship of one year duration can be integrated either after year 1 or year 2 of the BIB studies. During their internship students remain enrolled and still are students of the E.H.E. EurAka.

Naturally then, an internship adds further 60 ECTS credits to those 180 ECTS credits of the taught modules of the Bachelor in International Business programme. Transcript and Certificate then bear 240 ECTS credits in total.

In countries of delivery, where regulatory requirements request four years of studies for a Bachelor degree, the internship can be part of the overall structure of the BIB programme of studies.

Especially for studies in international business, gaining experiences through an internship is highly recommended. It is an experience, which goes far beyond the training of professional skills.

Admission by Education

The programme of studies addresses candidates, who have finished Further Education with a good College Degree, Baccalaureate or equivalent other national qualification. First professional experience is of advantage, but no prerequisite.



Admission by Work Experience

Applications from professionals without a College Degree or Baccalaureate or equivalent on national level, but can submit evidence of a credible professional education with their application instead, such as an apprenticeship or national equivalent, are equally encouraged to apply.

Those candidates having sufficient work experience (e.g. gained in an apprenticeship or in employment) may be admitted by providing written evidence of their professional experience. These candidates are invited seeking advice with the E.H.E. EurAka's Registry or their national centre of studies for further details and information through an individual assessment regarding the recognition of their existing qualification.
