The Europa Hochschule EurAka CH (E.H.E. European University EurAka Switzerland)



The E.H.E. Europa Hochschule EurAka CH, internationally known as the private European University EurAka Switzerland, is an independent and private University for integral medicine, technology, and economics. The E.H.E. EurAka is situated in Therwil (Switzerland) and legalised by the Swiss Federal Republic and the Canton Basel-Landschaft as private University. The status of the private EurAka University is officially confirmed as 'non-contributory private institution' according to the Swiss Higher Education Act (HFKG). The E.H.E. EurAka is officially approved to award Swiss Bachelor, Master's, and doctoral degrees.

The E.H.E. EurAka was constituted in 1985. The University provides national and international research and programmes of studies in the fields of Integral Medicine, Technological Sciences, and Business Sciences. The E.H.E. EurAka research, especially in technology and engineering, owns highest international reputation and attracts significant research funding from global


corporations and European Governments.

Upon recommendation by the State-Council of the Swiss Republic and the Canton Ticino, the E.H.E. EurAka has received official Degree Awarding Powers in the year 2000. The status of Degree and Research Degree Awarding Powers was reapproved by the country's various regulatory authorities in 2006, such as the Dipartimento della cultura e dell' educazione dello Sport, Ticino, and by the Canton Basel-Landschaft in 2016. They concluded that the E.H.E. Europa Hochschule EurAka CH is fully aligned with the laws of Switzerland and thus officially approved as Swiss "Hochschule on the level of University".

Switzerland itself is aligned with the so-called Bologna Process of the European Union making Degrees of the University cognate across Europe and beyond. Hence, the University awards Degrees with ECTS credits.

The Bachelor of Public Administration



The Bachelor of Public Administration is a focused programme of Undergraduate studies. It specifically prepares candidates for responsible and qualified roles in public services.

Sophisticated and contemporary modules qualify Graduates for working in various disciplines as 'all-rounders' - ones having highest levels of expertise and capabilities. The E.H.E. EurAka Graduates excel through superior knowledge and their capability to deliver best value to public services through cross-functional skills of relevance.

The BPA programme comprises three years as standard period of studies. It is conform with European requirements on undergraduate studies. With its comprehensiveness on superior level, the Degree awards 180 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System). The Bachelor of Public Administration strongly emphasises the concept of Employability Impact.

Key Elements of the BPA programme:

- Introduction to critical thinking and analytical approaches to theories and practices of contemporary contexts of public services by analysing their internal and external environment.
- Furthering of the ability to read, understand and make sense of the specific needs for sustainable progress in which public services have to operate.
- Development of the capacity to evaluate and critically analyse, how public services effectively and efficiently interact to deliver sustainable values.
- To provide insights into how stakeholders with often conflicting interests act, lobby, and try to influence decisions of public services.
- Apply own high standards of moral and ethical behaviour contributing to that of a public service organisation.

Graduates are awarded with the

- Certificate of the Bachelor of Public Administration being officially approved and part of the Process of Harmonisation of Higher Education in Europe (Bologna Process)
- The Transcript in form of the official Diploma Supplement 'Europass' of the European Union facilitating continuation to Master's studies internationally

This way, Graduates are equipped with outstanding knowledge and skills in the administration of public services, but also the right officially and widely recognised documentation for their Degree on international level.

Emphasis of the BPA Programme of Studies



- To introduce to and use theory, case study insights and practical demonstrations to enhance candidates' intellectual calibre, professional and future leadership skills and problem-solving capacity.
- To communicate sophisticated understandings of present and future problems and challenges typically found in contemporary public service organisations and to identify scope for general and particular improvements with reference to sustainability.
- To analyse and foster appropriate professional roles contributing to the general management of public service organisations. It further informs about the wider responsibilities by using sophisticated approaches to drive organisational development and to meet the needs of demanding constituents and multiple societal contexts.
- To explore the scope and content of organisational and functional effectiveness being focused on public services, their responsibilities and progress within the permanently changing environment in a national, international and global context.




For increased Employability Impact students can opt for an internship with a public service organisation of their choice. This offers experiences in practice in which knowledge gained on the BPA programme is extended. Such internship further enhances graduates' attractiveness, when they apply for a job.

The optional internship of one year duration can be integrated either after year 1 or year 2 of the BPA studies. During their internship students remain enrolled and still are students of the E.H.E. EurAka.

Naturally then, an internship adds further 60 ECTS credits to those 180 ECTS credits of the taught modules of the BPA programme. Transcript and Certificate bear 240 ECTS credits in total.

In countries of delivery, where regulatory requirements request four years of studies for a Bachelor Degree, the internship can be part of the overall structure of the BPA programme of studies.





General Entry Requirements

Admission by Education

The programme of studies addresses candidates, who have finished Further Education with a good College Degree, Baccalaureate or equivalent other national qualification. First professional experience is of advantage, but no prerequisite.



Admission by Work Experience

Applications from professionals without a College Degree or Baccalaureate or equivalent on national level, but can submit evidence of a credible professional education with their application instead, such as an apprenticeship or national equivalent, are equally encouraged to apply.

Those candidates having sufficient work experience (e.g. gained in an apprenticeship or in employment) may be admitted by providing written evidence of their professional experience. These candidates are invited seeking advice with the University's Registry or their national centre of studies for further details and information through an individual assessment regarding the recognition of their existing qualification.
