

The Europa Hochschule EurAka CH (E.H.E. European University EurAka Switzerland)



The E.H.E. Europa Hochschule EurAka CH, internationally known as the private European University EurAka Switzerland, is an independent and private University for integral medicine, technology, and economics. The E.H.E. EurAka is situated in Therwil (Switzerland) and legalised by the Swiss Federal Republic and the Canton Basel-Landschaft as private University. The status of the private EurAka University is officially confirmed as 'non-contributory private institution' according to the Swiss Higher Education Act (HFKG). The E.H.E. EurAka is officially approved to award Swiss Bachelor, Master's, and doctoral degrees.

The E.H.E. EurAka was constituted in 1985. The University provides national and international research and programmes of studies in the fields of Integral Medicine, Technological Sciences, and Business Sciences. The E.H.E. EurAka research, especially in technology and engineering, owns highest international reputation and attracts significant research funding from global

corporations and European Governments.

Upon recommendation by the State-Council of the Swiss Republic and the Canton Ticino, the E.H.E. EurAka has received official Degree Awarding Powers in the year 2000. The status of Degree and Research Degree Awarding Powers was reapproved by the country's various regulatory authorities in 2006, such as the Dipartimento della cultura e dell' educazione dello Sport, Ticino, and by the Canton Basel-Landschaft in 2016. They concluded that the E.H.E. Europa Hochschule EurAka CH is fully aligned with the laws of Switzerland and thus officially approved as Swiss "Hochschule on the level of University".

Switzerland itself is aligned with the so-called Bologna Process of the European Union making Degrees of the University cognate across Europe and beyond. Hence, the University awards Degrees with ECTS credits.



Regional E.H.E. EurAka Centres Around the Globe

Delivering studies in often very distant countries means trust first of all. Students have to trust that they are getting the same high quality as if studying with the E.H.E. EurAka herself. We must have the confidence that national centres of studies are exactly delivering this same quality.

The Bachelor in Hospitality Management



Key Elements of the Programme:

The Bachelor in Hospitality Management is a specific programme of studies preparing candidates for responsible and qualified roles in organisations of the hospitality industry or for self-employment.

Sophisticated and contemporary modules qualify graduates for working in this demanding industry - ones having highest levels of expertise and capabilities.

Graduates excel through superior knowledge and their capability to deliver best value through cross-functional skills of relevance.

The programme comprises three (or four) years as standard period of studies. It is conform with European requirements on undergraduate studies. With its comprehensiveness on superior level, the Degree awards 180/240 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System). The Bachelor in Hospitality Management strongly emphasises the concept of

Employability Impact.

- Introduction to critical thinking and analytical approaches to theories and practices of contemporary hospitality contexts by analysing the internal and external environment.
- Furthering of the ability to read, understand and make sense of the specific organisational needs for sustainable organisational progress in this particular industry.
- Development of the capacity to evaluate and critically analyse, how organisational functions effectively and efficiently interact.
- To provide insights into how various hospitality functions influence organisations' performance and how these may develop strategies for sustainable progress through effective service provision.
- Apply own high standards of moral and ethical behaviour.

Graduates are awarded with the

- Certificate of the Bachelor in Hospitality Management being officially approved and part of the Process of Harmonisation of Higher Education in Europe (Bologna Process)
- Transcript in form of the official Diploma Supplement 'Europass' of the European Union facilitating continuation to Master's studies internationally



Objectives of the Programme of Studies

- To use theory, case study insights, and practical demonstrations to develop students' intellectual calibre, professional and leadership skills, and problem-solving capacity for the hospitality industry.
- To communicate profound understandings of present and future opportunities and challenges typically found in contemporary hospitality organisations and to identify scope for general and particular improvements.
- To analyse and foster appropriate leadership roles embedded in the management of hospitality organisations and responsibilities by sophisticated approaches to drive organisational development and to meet the needs of demanding customers and multiple organisational constituents and contexts.
- To explore the scope and content of effective organisational and functional strategies focused on the hospitality industry, organisational sustainability, and progress within permanently changing environments.



Learning Outcomes of the Hospitality Programme

- Develop first critical thinking and analytical approaches to principles and practices of contemporary contexts in the hospitality industry by sound analysis of its internal and external environment.
- In addition, gain practical capabilities adding value to employers and their organisations, and being appreciated by customers.
- Develop the ability to read, understand, and make sense of specific organisational needs for sustainable progress in a variety of contexts of the hospitality industry.
- Introduce to evaluation and critical selection of strategies, tactics, and operational models in the contemporary and future-oriented hospitality management.
- Contribute to hospitality organisations through informed insights for practising socially responsible corporate citizenship and apply high standards of moral and ethical behaviour to the own work and to that of an organisation in the hospitality industry.

Admission by Education

The programme of studies addresses candidates, who have finished Further Education with a good College Degree, Baccalaureate or equivalent other national qualification. First professional experience is of advantage, but no prerequisite.



Admission by Work Experience

Applications from professionals without a College Degree or Baccalaureate or equivalent on national level, but can submit evidence of a credible professional education with their application instead, such as an apprenticeship or national equivalent, are equally encouraged to apply.

Those candidates having sufficient work experience (e.g. gained in an apprenticeship or in employment) may be admitted by providing written evidence of their professional experience. These candidates are invited seeking advice with the E.H.E. EurAka's Registry or their national centre of studies for further details and information through an individual assessment regarding the recognition of their existing qualification.
